Public Speaking

Demonstration

A public presentation that teaches by showing how

Illustrated Talk

A public presentation that teaches by telling how

Project Talk (only junior and intermediates)

Public presentation about a project that tells about the member's experiences in the project

Public Speaking (only seniors)

The skill of promoting or presenting an issue through a persuasive, entertaining, informational or inspiring speech

Impromptu

Presentation in which the speaker is given five minutes to prepare a five-minute speech on a randomly drawn topic about 4-H

Oral Interpretation

4-H'er creatively explores and develops a previously published work of literature for performance

Historical Speech

Reciting a portion of one speech previously given by someone else in a historical setting

Music

Vocal Solo, Ensemble or Chorus

Individual or group of 4-H'er performing with use of their voice

Instrumental Solo, Ensemble, Band or Orchestra

Individual or group of 4-H'er performing with use of an instrument

Piano Solo or Ensemble

Individual or group of 4-H'er performing with use of a piano

Dance

Dance Solo, Ensemble or Group

Individual or group performing a specific area of dance

Performing Arts

Skit

Skit that is improvised or lightly rehearsed; may either be improvisational in nature or may be loosely scripted and lightly rehearsed

One-Act Play

Basic principles of staging, blocking, and performing before an audience

Acting Solo or Due

Presenting a monologue (solo acting) or a scene with two characters (duo acting)

Novelty Solo, Duo or Group

Grouping that may include novelty acts such as mime, puppets, magic routines, ventriloquist acts, baton routines, gymnastic routines, stand-up comedy, or other original material

Parliamentary Procedure

Gavel Games

Group of 4-5 4-H'ers do a parliamentary procedure demonstration

Model Meeting

Clubs complete a mock 4-H club meeting

Cloverbuds

Show and Share

Public presentation where a Cloverbud 4-H'er tells about a specific object that applies to 4-H
